# Equipment today: Simple, but working










### More "sophisticated", but NOT working

### - - and ALARA does not exist!








## **Summary of problems:**

- ✓ There will *never* be enough qualified staff where needed **Solution:** Tele-radiology using digital equipment
- **✓** There will *never* be sufficiently good diagnostic quality of radiographs produced


Solution: Get rid of film and film processing using digital equipment
