- Grassroots collaborative, no-fee publishing service for open educational resources (OER) created in Alberta
- Educators from partnered post-secondary institutions across Alberta may use this service.
- Formally launched in 2020, has 12 partners and growing
- Uses Pressbooks software, based on WordPress
- Hosted by the University of Alberta Library
- OER types you may create include open textbooks, toolkits, guides, and more.

Open Educational Resources (OER) are:

Learning, teaching and research materials in any format and medium that reside in the public domain or are under copyright that have been released under an open license, that permit no-cost access, re-use, repurpose, adaptation and redistribution by others.



# Features in Pressbooks

- Editing WYSIWYG interface: WordPress visual and text HTML editor
- Different roles & permissions available (administrator, editor, author, etc.)
- Glossary
- Textboxes and tables
- Multi-media enrichment: audio, video, graphics, simulations
- Mathematical notations: <u>QuickLaTex</u>
- Social annotation: <u>Hypothes.is</u>
  - Options for public, private groups (course discussion, editorial review), and personal notes and highlighting
- Interactive elements: <u>H5P</u>




