

Calgary Metropolitan Plan Update

June 21, 2012 saw a significant achievement for the Calgary Regional Partnership (CRP): the approval of the [Calgary Metropolitan Plan](#). The 14 Executive members that represent the CRP's member municipalities voted unanimously to approve the revised Plan, which has been sent to the [Government of Alberta](#) for review and eventual legislation.

The Plan's approval capped an exciting CRP General Assembly that included a little something for anyone interested in the Calgary Region's future. [Video presentations](#), interactive displays and the [who's who of the Calgary Region](#) brought the Assembly to life. A heartfelt tribute was included for the late Rick Butler who was one of the original founders of the CRP and key developers of the Metropolitan Plan.

"The enthusiasm at the General Assembly was overwhelming," said Truper McBride, Chair of the Calgary Regional Partnership and Mayor for the Town of Cochrane. "The Calgary Regional Partnership has invested so much into the Calgary Metropolitan Plan, and it's gratifying to see our region come together and collaborate on causes that are so important to its sustainability."

Alberta Municipal Affairs Minister Doug Griffiths also provided key words of support indicating a positive reception by the Province. He also commended the CRP for setting an example of working together to steward the region's natural resources and plan for future generations.

With the passage of the [Calgary Metropolitan Plan](#), the hard work of implementation begins. The first step will be to build upon the momentum from the General Assembly and build awareness of the Plan's benefits. Watch for CRP will be coming to member municipalities this Fall and Winter.
